The SH scholarship scheme

- Established in 2013
- Coordinated by TPF since 2015
- Objectives
 - Study opportunity for foreign students in Hungary
 - Promotion of Hungarian HE
 - Internationalisation of Hungarian HE
 - Quality development





Scholarship holders are provided with

Tuition-free education

exemption from the payment of tuition fee during the time of scholarship

Monthly stipend

- non-degree, bachelor, master and one-tier master level: monthly HUF 43 700 (cca EUR 130)
- doctoral level: according to the current Hungarian legislation, it is monthly HUF 140 000 (cca EUR 450) for the first phase of education (4 semesters) and HUF 180 000 (cca EUR 580) for the second phase (4 semesters)

Accommodation

dormitory place or a monthly contribution of HUF 40 000 (cca 130 EUR) to accommodation costs

Medical insurance

health care services according to the relevant Hungarian legislation (national health insurance card) and supplementary medical insurance





HEI application

- Call for applications: 3 years (+complementary CFA each year)
- Main focus
 - Internationalisation level of the HEI & faculties (overall readiness)
 - HEI undertakings
 - Quality of study programmes





HEI - application

- Evaluation of overall readiness: external peer review (2 experts)
 - HEI internationalisation strategy
 - HR investment
 - Student services
 - International promotion
 - HEI undertakings
- Minimum requirement: 65/100 pts.





HEI - application

- Evaluation of study programmes: TPF
 - Ratio of international students
 - Teacher/student mobility
 - Previous experience
 - Statistical data
 - Quotas
 - Study programme cost offer





HEI - application

- Evaluation: experts + TPF
- Offer decision (cost of each study programme): TPF Board of Trustees
- Acceptance of offers: HEI
- TPF-HEI contract for SH implementation





HEI - implementation

- Admission examination
- Enrolment of scholarship holders (contract)
- Disbursement of scholarship
