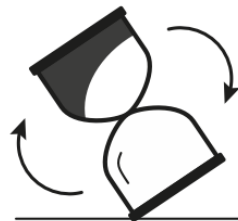

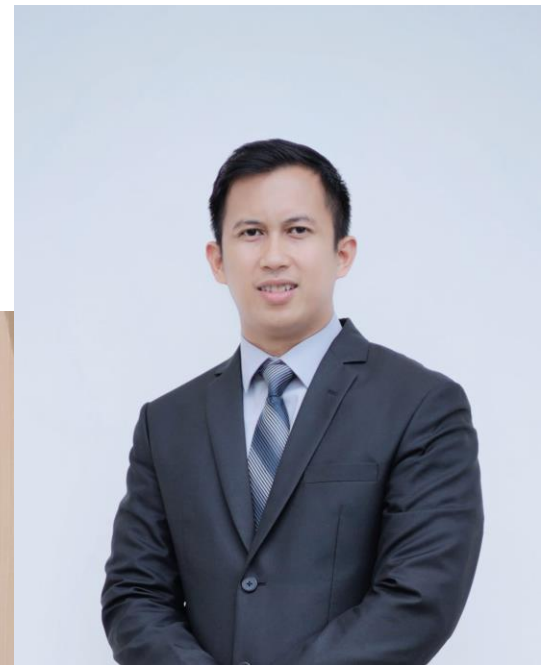

I think I like the the bridge. The bridge from from a distance, not too close.

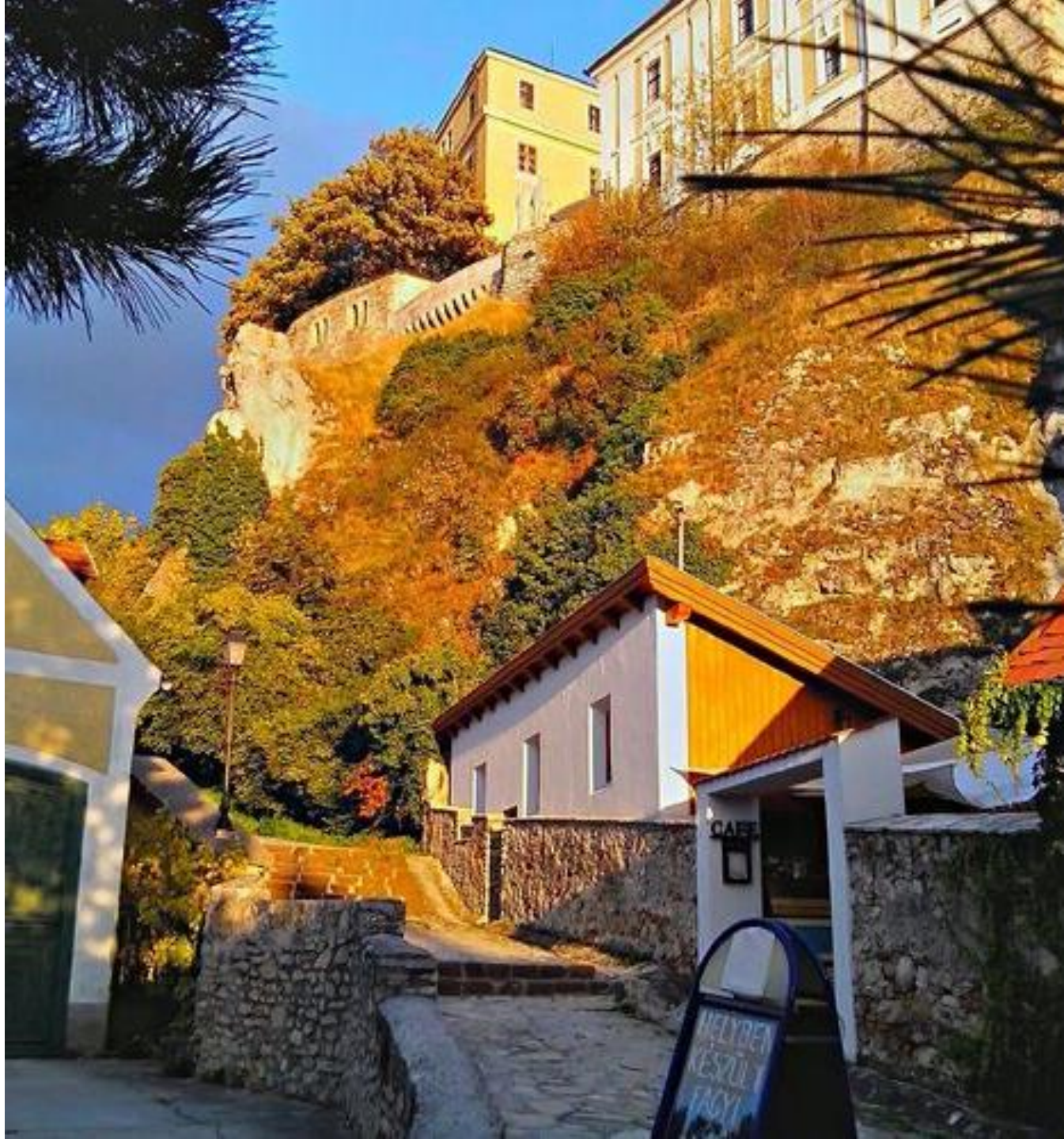
It's very beautiful from a distance, and it's one of the things I like is and.

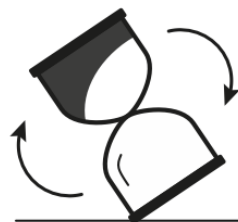
