


TEMPUS PUBLIC FOUNDATION



- Background institution of the Ministry of Human Capacities
- Founded in 1996, 20 years of expertise
- Goal to support HU education and training institutions in international cooperation
 - implementing agency for European and national, multi-, bilateral educational programmes
 - mobility and knowledge management
- Stability in fundamental values
 - Transparent, standard operation (regular controls and checks by national authorities and the EU), ISO 9001
 - High professional standards





















BASIC FACTS ABOUT HUNGARIAN HIGHER EDUCATION




- First university established in 1367

- Member of European Higher Education Area (Bologna Process)





HUNGARIAN HE INTERNATIONALISATION GOALS




- By 2023 20% of the graduates shall have international learning experience and increasing the number of foreign students to 40 000
- Increasing high quality higher education offer (programs) and high quality higher education services for international students
- Higher educational modernization, increasing quality of higher education for Hungarian students as well
- Large variety of international students on university campuses: enhancing values of the international classroom, internationalization at home, intercultural skills
- Larger attractiveness, global visibility, attracting top talents, enlarging the Hungarian scientific global network








HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS - SH

Doctoral Master Bachelor


















STUDENTS - SH








SH STUDENTS BY HEI

QUALITY ASSURANCE OF THE PROGRAMME



- Continuous monitoring of
 - Higher education institutions
 - Scholarship holders
 - Tempus Public Foundation
- Surveying students' satisfaction (yearly)
- Institutional reporting on implementation and students' performance
- Close cooperation with Hungarian Rectors' Conference, Ministry of Human Capacities and Foreign Trade and Relations





RESULTS



- Student performance:
 - Average SH scholarship holder's study performance is 10% higher than an average other student's
 - Only 5 to 15 % of SH students underperforms slightly or considerably
- Drop out rate: very low (1.5%)
- Overall student satisfaction: stable, slightly increasing
- 96% of students would choose Hungary as a study destination again





CHALLENGES



- Dynamic expansion of the programme
 - Increase the use of annual quota of countries
 - Ideally there should be 3x more applicants than quota
- Transparent selection process of nomination
 - To select the best students and increase the success level of entry examination
 - Ideally there should be at least 20% more nominees than quota
- Assistance needed to evaluate certificates from the sending country



CHALLENGES



- Starting the visa procedure early
- Arriving in time early September
- Following up graduates
 - Recognition of Hungarian degrees in your country
- Creating / strengthening bonds between Hungarian and your institutions
- Mutual exchange of students
 - More information in time
